

1. What is "Kawarake Nage"?

Kawarake Nage is one thing we want you to remember and try at the Kasamatsu Park. Kawarake Nage refers to throwing an unglazed or sunbaked earthen dish from a high place, wishing protection from evil, fulfilling your wish and so on. Here in Nariai mountain, if you throw Kawarake and it can pass through **Chie-no-Wa**, it is said that a fortune will knock at your door.





Put **200yen** into the payment box and take three Kawarake out from the shelf. It is self-service.

Note; 1000yen note cannot be used because it frequently clogs in the coin slot. The bill changer is just your left as soon as you enter our souvenir shop.



Throw the Kawarake aiming at the center of the "Chie-no-Wa" as in the photo.
